

**Pat** (20) a student in the adult transition class. Wants to work at the local hamburger restaurant when she gets out of school. TBI, intellectual impairment, seizure disorder. Loves to sing and go dancing with her friends.

**Kent** (14) a high school freshman with Down's syndrome. Works for the school newsletter and wants to be a news anchor when he grows up. Has a severe tree nut allergy and carries an epi-pen.

**Logan** (13) a middle school student loves the Hulk and talks about the character nonstop. As a child on the autism spectrum he thrives on routine, gets upset with change can be obsessive (i.e.: The Hulk), and can have unexpected outbursts that involve running away when frustrated. As a result, loading the bus in the afternoon can be a challenge when he has a frustrating day.

**Dreamer** (16) a high school student who has ambulatory challenges and has transitioned from a walker to independent movement. She is non communicative and has uncontrolled grabbing impulses. Through her facial expressions there is communication and she is able to hum basic songs. She will sometimes cry if emotional or frustrated and can be easily redirected with soothing voices and "softies". Overall a happy student.
